







Measure the space between the studs, then use the Metal Cutting Circular Saw to cut the lengths of the fixed backing (TFB) being sure you choose the end which matches your needs (open to hard, open to open or hard to hard)










TRUFLUSH Installation Tips





Once clamped and aligned to the chalk line, the makeup clip is fastened to the stud first with open channel facing forward







Followed by the two or three #10 hex head fasteners through the pilot holes on the adjacent stud backing through the stud attaching through the flange on the adjacent backing component





Once both ends of the backing are fastened, attach two #10 hex head fasteners through the top and bottom of the makeup clip





If needed, two fasteners can then be attached through the side of the U shaped bend pilot holes catching the return lip on the edge of the stud flange
